## **Goodwill Industries of Arkansas Kicks Off Salt Bowl Donation Drive Competition Between Benton and Bryant August 15**

**LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (August 15, 2022)** — Back for the fifth consecutive year, Benton and Bryant are extending their rivalry beyond the field to positively impact their communities. Both areas are encouraged to participate in the 2022 Salt Bowl Donation Drive Competition which begins today, August 15.

The number of financial and household donations will be totaled Friday, August 26. The winning district will be named and presented with a check and trophy for bragging rights before kickoff at 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 27.
